## Welcome to our 3-Valleys Skiing plus Spain's Andalusian Relaxation Adventure

Join us on our skiing adventure in France's well known 3-Valleys, where we'll stay in the centrally located Les Menuires resort. Our post-ski R&R will be in Spain's Andalusian region where we'll visit their ocean resort of Marbella, Granada and Seville. On our return trip we'll stay a couple days in Madrid for some gustatory & cultural experiences.



### **Les Menuires Resort:**

Is a ski resort in France's expansive 3-Valleys (Les Trois Vallées) complex which encompasses other well-known venues as Courchevel, Meribel, and Val Thorens, among others. The resort is a self-contained "village" with 48 restaurants and a range of non-skiing facilities. For the skiers, it has advanced ski slopes and beginner slopes with 39 ski lifts and 62 trails, which are connected solely via 183 ski lifts to more than 600 km of slopes in [Les Trois Vallées](#), making it a part of the largest skiable area in the world using a single ski pass. In addition, there are 120 km of cross-country skiing.



### **The Andalusian region:**

Is steeped in Moorish culture, architecture and cuisine. Marbella is a chic sea resort located in the sun drenched Costa del Sol in the foothills of the Sierra Blanca. It provides easy access to nearby Granada plus the ski slopes of the Sierra Nevada. We'll spend three nights in Marbella and travel by bus to Granada for a day tour of the famous Alhambra. Another bus trip to Sevilla will provide us with three days to absorb its many attractions and culture. A rapid rail trip to Madrid where we'll stay overnight will cap our Spanish Adventure.

Granada, within a 2-hour drive from Marbella, is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada Mountains and ski resort. The Alhambra, a Moorish citadel and palace, is the most renowned architectural relic of the Andalusian Islamic legacy and one of the most popular destinations in Spain. This region goes back in history to at least 5500 B.C. It came under Moorish control in 711 A.D. whose influence in many aspects of the city, especially its architecture, are evident to this day. We'll take a day tour of city.

## Seville:



Seville (*Sevilla* in Spanish) is the capital of the *Andalusia* autonomous region and the province of Seville. Situated as an inland port on the River Guadalquivir, it became the sole in-and-out port for trade with the new world just after Columbus' discovery, prospering from this advantage for many decades during which its population grew to over one million! A phenomenon during that period in history. It is over 2,200 years old,

founded by the Romans and later conquered by the Moors in 712, whose influence left an everlasting imprint on the city; particularly its architecture. Seville is a city of contrast between the old and the modern, offering both aspects to its visitors.
