This is a Blue Ridge Ski Council organized “Western Carnival” ski trip, and as such it is a fun-filled adventure with fabulous skiing; parties, and pleasant camaraderie with other BRSC member clubs’ participants.

Located just 40 minutes from Salt Lake City Airport, unmatched accessibility, deep powder, exciting terrain, a pedestrian slopeside village and first-class services combine to make Snowbird an unparalleled Utah destination. Snowbird averages approximately 500 inches of low-density, "dry" Utah powder annually and 3,240 vertical feet of terrain for all ski levels (27% beginner; 38% intermediate; 35% advanced). Nearby Alta offers 700 inches of annual snow thanks to ideal geography and a phenomenon called “Lake Effect”. Little Cottonwood Canyon is known worldwide for reliable powder snow conditions.

**Cliff Lodge & Spa:** Lodging for the entire Blue Ridge Ski Council will be ski in- ski out at the Snowbird Cliff Lodge. The Cliff Lodge is all about convenience, full of many services and amenities all under one roof. Within walking distance to Snowbird’s pedestrian village, The Cliff Lodge offers comfortable lodging for the whole family or group. An on-site ski rental and repair shop and complimentary ski lockers add to the onvenience of the hotel. Other amenities include an exercise room, room service, concierge and a state-licensed daycare facility.
